



## BURAK MORITZ

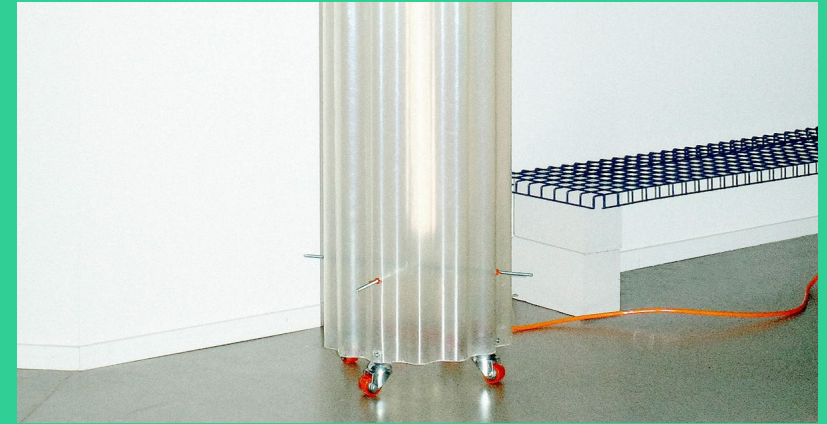
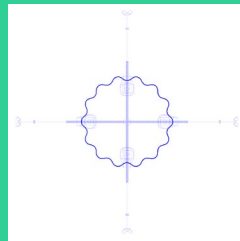
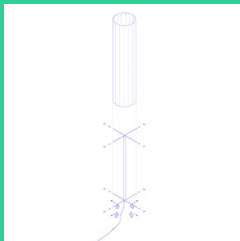
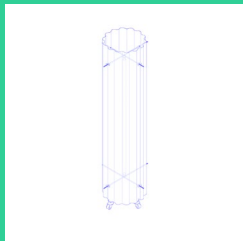

## 1500 x 350 x 1

We think the less we look at the world in that pre-conceived way, or established categories, the more we uncover new things - that can be found all around us. This approach to the natural world would offer an alternative to the stylistic debates. Valuing what exists is the best starting point for an open-minded approach: potential new directions as an inspiration and motivation for further development of daily life objects, unexpected and new possible answers. 1500x350x1 is not designed. It is a collection, an assemblage of banal building materials. It is assembled by hand, no tools are required. 1500x350x1 is not a „standing“ lamp, it moves, rotates, occupies and creates spaces. Threaded rods and wing nuts force the corrugated polyester roofing sheets in a geometrical circle, a rather unnatural shape for the flat roofing sheets. Heavy duty rollers with a load capacity of 100kg are carrying the thin PVC skirt and light stainless steel skeleton, making it seemingly weightless float a few centimeters above the ground. When turned off, the LED tube is almost invisible through the light green, translucent polyester sheets. Switched on, the LED light seems to float in the center, emitting a soft warm light.
