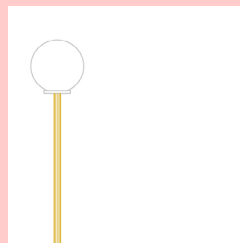
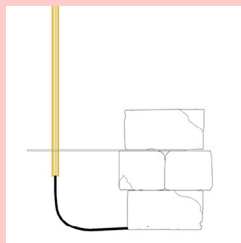
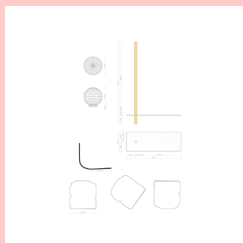

BED NIGHT LIGHT

In the Eastern blocks of Europe 30% of the population still lives in post-war modernist concrete panel flats. As precast concrete structures were specifically designed to have a lifespan of 50 years, many opinions clash if these structures are possible to be kept or have to be demolished. The amount of waste produced by demolishing concrete is significant, not to mention the energy needed to produce cement. Hence this project tries an other approach by repurposing some elements of construction. During a flat renovation a lot of debris piles up which would end up as waste, so this provides an opportunity.
