
His relationship with design starts very early, making furnitures for himself, than later for others, and for his city, with pieces of urban forniture.

THE BOOKSHELF THAT WENT MISSING

In 1987 architects Giulio Muratori and Pierino Zanon from Studio Muratoi & Zanon designed a bookshelf called Menhir for a local marble industry Marmi e Pietre. A limited edition that went sold out almost immediately. Only two pieces remained, one to each architect. After the death of Zanon in 2014, his house was sold, together with every pieces of furniture inside, to a friend who greatly appreciated his design.

The piece in Muratori's possession, even though the marble piece was huge and massive, is now lost. Marmi e Pietre is now closed, and the drawings of Menhir are lost in the thousands of drawings of the 40 years old office.

Only the ghost of the library now appears, if someone is able to remember it.
