


DISCO DIVA

The Fural® metal roof, an invention of the Swiss architect Josef Furrer, is still an innovation after more than 70 years. Almost forgotten in the past years, it's recently rediscovered! Thanks to the unique design, you can just roll out the sleek Fural® stripes, fixing them without attachment to the substructure (no visible screws). Using the Material in one of our projects (Rooftop Extension Saumacker) we are fascinated by the simplicity and rawness of the material! Coming to construction sites in huge rolls, they just have to be unrolled and fixed.

It's shiny, it's Alu blank!

It's industrialized, but unique!

It's ordinary, but extraordinary!

From rolled to unrolled to rolled!

From Stripes to Rolls to Stripes!

From Roll to Disco Diva!!!

We take one Roll and add a perforation pattern. We add different light sources and will hang it from the ceiling. And voilà, we create a huge disco ball!
