MOON CLOCK

When it gets darker, on top of buildings, luminous and colorful symbols of urbanity appear.

Despite their usual privateness, those sky signs are able to convey in a simple and direct way a strong sense of collectivity, as their radiance belongs to the city. They are able to inform, communicate, and tell stories on a wider scale.

Historically, clocks appeared in the urban landscape in order to organize a daily rhythm, respect working hours, and observe prayer times. Clocks usually indicate the time dictated by the sun. But another time exists, perhaps more imperceptible but nevertheless tangible, which is the time linked to the movements of the moon - the time of tides and women, of love and feasts.

The Moon Clock is a collective reminder not to forget this invisible time.

The version of the Moon Clock presented at the Salone 24 is the reduction in scale 1:2 of the original clock which will be installed in Place Roger (Brussels) on the Facade of the Palace Hotel, a project developed by Pandox, designed by Onsitestudio and Piovenefabi. The Moon Clock is the result of a collaboration with the Paris-based artist Simon Boudvin.
